Safety in the Team

- Everyone is responsible for staying safe
 - Not just the Safety Captain
- Team Safety Manual kept in 30
 - Contains all information

General Safety

- Common sense
- Personal protection
- Clean up
- No playing around

Personal Protection

- Goggles
- Hair tied up
- Close toed shoes
- No loose fitting clothing
- Gloves
- Hearing protection

Goggles

- In the shop
- Pit
- Competition
- Using any tools

In case of an accident...

- Report to Shop Manager or other upperclassman member of the team
 - One band-aid rule
- Safety Incident report
- First-aid
 - clean / disinfect
 - band-aid

Tool Safety

- Clamp
- Personal Protection
- Listening to the tool
- Emergency stop vs. turning tool off
- Emergency stop
 - Location
 - Not a toy
 - When you need to distance yourself from tool
- If you don't need to distance yourself, use the off button

Soldering


- Ventilation
 - Air vents in shop
 - Fume hood
